Any school is expected to maintain high levels of amenity, health and safety and not unreasonably impact on adjoining occupiers.
- 2. Places the Policy on Public Exhibition for a period of 42 days for the purposes of receiving further public submissions.
- 3. Receives a further report following the public exhibition period subject to the receipt of submissions and/or if the draft policy is proposed to be amended.
- 4. Authorises the adoption of the Draft Policy Keeping of Animals (Urban Areas) (2024) if:
 - a) No submissions are received; or
 - b) No new submission themes/matters being raised, to the satisfaction of the General Manager; or
 - c) If no amendments to the policy are required to be made.
